THE STUDY OF GOD #3 – THE ATTRIBUTES OF GOD

• Attributes. What God does. 2 classes of attributes:

1. Non- Moral Attributes.

- Immutability. God is unchangeable and unchanging Ps. 102:26-27. God is unchangeable in His nature Heb. 13:8, His Word Ps. 119:160, His Will, His power Rom. 4:20-21, His plans and purposes Is. 46:10, His promises 2 Cor. 1:20.
- Omnipresence God is "all present" Jer. 23:23-24, Ps. 139:7-12.
- Omniscience God is "all knowing" Ps. 147:5.
- Omnipotence God is "all powerful" Gen. 17:1. God's omnipotence is seen in His creation Ps. 33:4-9, nature Ps. 107:25-29, men Is. 40:15, Satan Job 1:10, 12, redemption Acts 9.
- 2. **Moral Attributes of God** the moral qualities of God.
 - Holiness. The holiness of God is the first place character or attribute of God – Ps. 47:8, 89:14, 94:2. The holiness of God is taught by:
 - 1. Statement. Throughout the OT God is called the "Holy One of Israel" (about 30 times is Isaiah) Lev. 11:44-45, Joshua 24:19, 1 Sam. 2:2.
 - 2. Separation Ex. 19:12-13, 26:33, 1 Kings 6:16, Lev 1-7.
 - **3.** The New Testament. Holiness is seen in all three Persons of the Godhead John 17:11, Acts 3:14, 13:52.
 - 4. Punishment of evil doers Nadab and Abihu Lev. 10:1-3.
 - 5. Visions seen by men of God Moses Ex. 33:18-23, Isaiah 6:1-6, John Rev. 4:8-11.
 - 6. Provisions of a Redeemer 2 Cor. 5:21.
 - Righteousness Ezra 9:15, Neh. 9:33, John 17:25.
 - **Judgment** God's judgment of sin. There are 2 types of justice in the Bible Remunerative rewards righteousness, **Deut. 7:9, 12-13** and Punitive punishes disobedience of righteousness **Gen. 2:17.**

- Faithfulness Lam. 22-23. God is faithful to His promises Adam Gen. 3:15, Abraham Gen. 15:13 -, David 1 Kings 8:56, man after the flood Gen. 6:11-13.

- Love 1 John 4:10, 16.
- Grace Rom. 3:21-25.
